**MEMBERS PRESENT:** Dale Pomeroy, Aaron Bacon, Esther Borte, Mike Morgan, Jill Davis, Jim Fluckinger, and Jon Cravens.

**CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Chairman Dale Pomeroy.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Aaron made a motion to approve the April 13, 2016 meeting minutes, Esther seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

**SECRETARY'S REPORT:** The gentlemen with Hagerty Farms have left the campground for now. They may be coming back throughout the summer. For the month of May we generated over \$1500 from their camping. We also have a few camping reservations coming up in July.

**NEW BUSINESS: Cheese Day Bazaar.** There was little participation last year for the bazaar. The City Hall staff has only had one inquiry for this year. The board agreed that it was not a success and did not want to hold the Cheese Day Bazaar for 2016.

**OLD BUSINESS: RCO Grant Application.** Jill and Michelle have completed the first round of the application process. They presented the application to the RCO Funding Board last month and got some great feedback. They are in the process of making changes to the application and the slide show presentation. The next presentation will be done in August.

**Steamboat Alley.** Progress is being made on the Steamboat Alley project. Painting on the adjacent buildings has been done and they have had some work parties. The next work party is set for Sunday, June 12<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. They will be focusing on building some planter boxes.

Jill explained that the alley way is currently not listed as a pocket park in our Park Recreation and Comprehensive Plan and it should be. Mike motioned to have Steamboat Alley designated as a pocket park and add it to the plan. Aaron seconded, motion carried unanimously.

**Walk In the Park Fundraiser.** A meeting was held yesterday with the Walk in the Park committee. Mike has created a t-shirt design and Jill is working on t-shirt prices. Esther has made a quilt that the Lady Lionesses will be raffling off. They will also be donating water to the participants. Jamie Cummings has drafted a donation request letter. All proceeds from this fundraiser will be used as a partial match for the RCO grant that we are applying for to renovate

the campground and add the RV dump station.

**Rose Garden.** Dale said that the rose garden area is basically done. If Katie is to receive any more donations she will surely plant them but she has planted all that she had. Dale and Aaron are talking of replacing the rotten wood curbing with a concrete one. Aaron has a curb machine that could be used. Jim said he would donate bags of concrete and help them out.

**OTHER BUSINESS: Wood Shed.** Jon said that the wood in the wood shed is almost gone. At this time there are no plans to replenish it. Board members will spread the word and see what can be done.

**Camping Fees.** Jim had concerns with the process of collecting the camping money and camp site reservations. Jill explained the process that is in place for both.

**ADJOURN:** As there was no further business, Aaron made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Mike seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting was adjourned.
