CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Chairman Dale Pomeroy.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Aaron made a motion to approve the June 08, 2016 meeting minutes, Mike seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Jill made a request to have next month's meeting on the 3rd Wednesday (September 21, 2016).

NEW BUSINESS: Park Sign. City Council was approached with placing 2 signs in the park that state that the park is Closed From Dusk to Dawn. They have sent the request to the Park Board. Currently there is no sign that states this and there have been many people in the park all hours of the night, some taking showers and some just wandering through. The board asked Ric if the people are causing problems. He said that when an issues arises he calls 9-1-1 and the police respond. He would just like to see something posted so he can direct them to the sign and the Police Department can have people removed after hours. The cost of the signs is \$42.05, plus tax, each. Aaron made a motion to recommend to the City Council that a sign be purchased and placed on the gate that says "Park Closed Dusk to Dawn Unless a Paid Camper." Mike seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS: RCO Grant Application. The final application has been turned in and accepted by RCO. The final presentation will be on August 31st in Olympia.

Steamboat Alley. The sewer line was repaired today. Jamie Cummings is selling pavers to have placed in the alleyway as a fundraiser. On August 21, 2016 they will be starting the first task with the mural, all are welcome to stop by.

Walk In the Park Fundraiser. Flyers have been printed and are available. Jill asked that the board please spread the word. Registration forms are available at City Hall. Early bird registration ends on September 7th. Jill is looking into getting in at the school on August 25th for Meet the Teacher night to distribute flyers. We have had a few sponsors so far but are looking for more. We are also looking for prize baskets to be donated.

Mike spoke with the Lions Club and they will do the hot dog bbq.

Rose Garden. Dale said that Katie has been watering and weeding the area. This Fall she plans on purchasing a few more plants herself.

OTHER BUSINESS: Oregon Trail Monument. The Daughters of American Revolution were in town on Monday and cleaned up the Oregon Trail Monument by the Assembly of God church. Common Ground plans on adding plants and flowers around the base of the monument. A rededication is in the works for the near future.

Information Board. The information board in the park was hit during the Cheese Day BBQ and broke. The posts seem to have been rotten. Public Works will be working on fixing it.
