CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
June 17, 2019**

**MAYOR STEVE DOBOSH CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER. THE FLAG SALUTE WAS LED BY MAYOR DOBOSH.**

**COUNCIL MEMBERS PRESENT:** Emily Morgan, Carol Hill, Glenda Forga, Ron Neumann and Guy Spratt.

**CONSENT AGENDA APPROVING CITY COUNCIL MINUTES OF JUNE 3, 2019.** Guy motioned to approve the consent agenda; Glenda seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

**DEPARTMENT REPORTS:**

**Steve Dobosh – Mayor:** Nothing to report.

**Jon Cravens – Public Works:** Jon Cravens was excused and his report is in packets. Michelle also notified Council that we have hired two part time summer help workers.

**John Brockmueller – Police Department:** John was on vacation. Officer Pennington reported the two candidates in the Reserve Academy are doing great with a possibility of helping on Cheese Days.

**Michelle Whitten– City Clerk:** The income salary survey did not go well. Toledo Low to Moderate Income was at almost 43% and we needed 51%. Michelle did write to the agencies on her displeasure of how it was conducted, sampling and no help from City staff or Mayor. There were 48% of the households contacted that would not give their information. Although we did not qualify for Community Development Block Grant our engineers were told it would be good to turn it in anyway, so we did.

Mondo Croquet is happening this Saturday in the City Park. Jaimie explained the concept and sledge hammers and bowling balls will be used. This is a fundraiser for parks.

**Water Leak Reduction Request – 511 Pine Street-** Carol motioned to approve the water leak reduction request, Glenda seconded. Ron Neumann asked if all qualifications have been met, Michelle said, Yes. Motion carried unanimously.

**PUBLIC.** Jaimie Cummings said the Thursday Market is full and requests to use the entire parking lot. The bathrooms have been locking at 6:00 p.m. and market goes until 7:00 p.m. Council discussed many options to include closing off Front Street, signs eliminating parking on Thursdays, detour signs, etc. Jaimie did say that this may be temporary until the new building is finished in July. Ron motioned to expand the market to the entire parking lot then in the ensuing weeks count traffic use at the boat launch, Glenda seconded. Motion carried unanimously

Jake Morgan popped in to let Council know Toledo Lions Club is working on a trail on 6<sup>th</sup> Street with a partnership with the cemetery and school. This will include a bridge and sets of stairs. Michelle suggested he get a map with description to Council.
