MEMBERS PRESENT: Mike Morgan, Jamie Cummings, Jill Davis, and Mike Fisher.

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by Chairman Mike Morgan.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Jamie made a motion to approve the September 16, 2020 meeting minutes, Jill seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: City Council approved the \$2,000 request for the campsite improvements in 2021.

Park is closed to vehicle traffic for the winter. The restroom will remain open for the walk-in guests to use.

NEW BUSINESS:

OLD BUSINESS: Jail Improvement Update. The jail was vandalized with paint. Common Ground would like to change up the mural idea for the jail and have stencils done up that would be placed on the jail. The community would be able to come by and paint within these stencils. The hope is that the community will take pride in this project as they were a part of it and possible deter future vandalism.

Jamie made a motion to recommend that all four sides of the jail be enhanced with a community painted mural rather than the one-sided design. The new design will be approved by City Council before it is painted. Jill seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

OTHER BUSINESS: Facility Inventory List. Jamie is working on this inventory list.

Old WWTP Ponds. No updates currently.

Welcome to Toledo Sign. Mike explained again that the Public Works Department will need to be in contact with the Tilley Family to set up a time to have this sign installed. Is it possible to have the sign attached to the existing post that is installed currently at the end of the launch?

Santa ATV/UTV Parade. The parade is scheduled for December 5, 2020. The parade will allow 4-wheelers and UTV's only. No candy will be thrown out. It will end at the Boat Launch with the tree lighting. More information is on the group's Facebook page.

City Park Light Display. Would it be possible to restart the light display in the City Park and have it opened drive thru? The City would allow this and support this idea. The main concern is keeping the vehicles on the rocked roadway. They cannot pull over into the grass areas to let other by or take photos.
